Books on literature can be found from the library's home page using the library's online catalog.

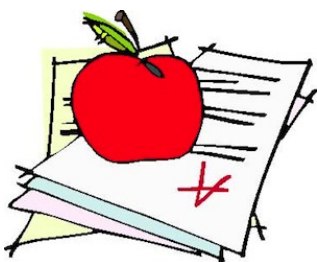
Many books are available in ebook form. While we may not have these books in print form, we do have them available to be read

from your computer or other device.

Enter a title, author or subject in the **Search Resources** box. Narrow the search by clicking on Kilgore College, Watson Library and Book. Print books will have a call number used

to find the book on the shelf.

To view an ebook, click **View eBook**. Next, click on **Full Text**. Click **Search within** and enter your search terms. Click on a page number to go to that page.



Remember the Works Cited

As your English instructor will tell you, it is important to get all of the information you need to write your Works Cited page. Make sure you have all the bibliographic information before you leave! It is much easier to get it the first time than it

is to come back later and try to find the right book or document.
